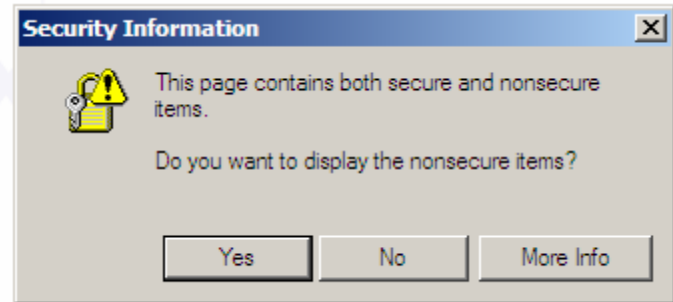


Internet Explorer - Repeated Prompt to Confirm Viewing 'Mixed Content'

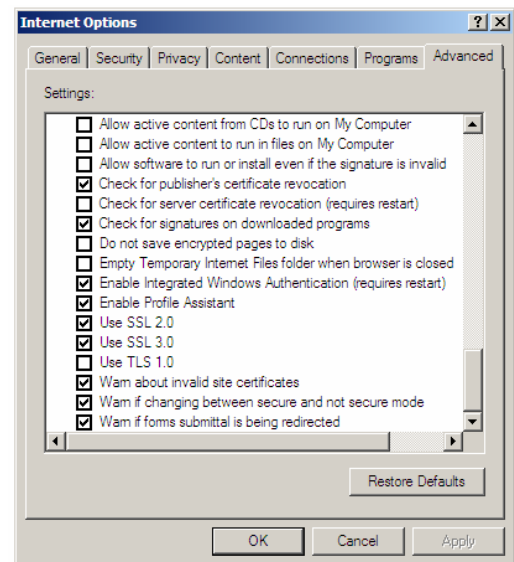
Some versions of Internet Explorer default to security settings in which the user is prompted when opening many screens with a confirm dialog similar to the one shown here.

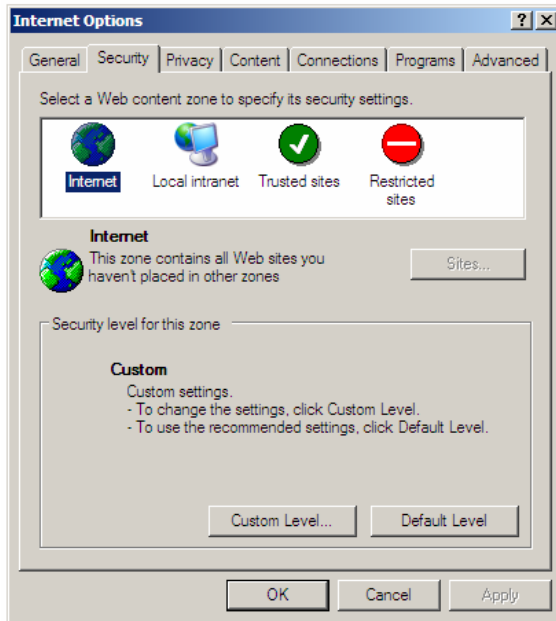


This is caused because Internet Explorer has been configured to prompt when some elements of the web page being received are not encrypted. In the SSI EasyTrak / EPM360 environment this may apply to some displayed images.

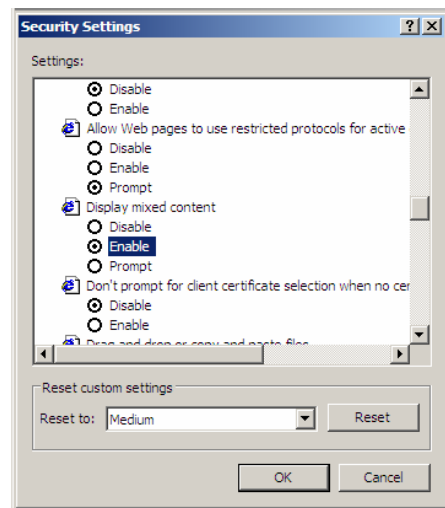
In order to suppress this prompt proceed as follows:

1. If you are using Internet Explorer 7, and the usual 'File, Edit, View, Favorites...' menu is not displayed, click on **Tools**, and then **Menu Bar** on the right side.
2. Click on **Tools - Internet Options** and then the **Advanced** tab, and scroll down to the bottom of the screen, as shown here:
3. Find the check box labeled Warn if changing between secure and insecure mode – and make sure it is unchecked.
4. Click **Apply**. Do not click **OK** yet!
5. Now go back to the **Security** tab to the left, as shown below, and select the 'Zone' into which you have placed `skillsense.com`
 Note: unless you have changed it manually to the **Trusted Zone**, this will be the **Internet Zone** by default.





6. Click on the Custom Level button, and a screen similar to that shown below will open.
7. Scroll down to the selection labeled Enable Mixed Content.
8. Ensure that Enabled is selected.



9. Finally click OK twice to dismiss both screens.
10. Note: You may need to restart Internet Explorer for the changes to take effect.
